Dan Kunz, who is a member of our region, has a concept car that is one of one! He has been in the process of a full restoration of his 1970 Jeep Bolide XJ002. Total restorations are never easy, but Dan's car has presented some unique challenges. After applying for acceptance from the AACA, he finally got an acceptance letter from them that they have accepted the Jeep for a special class that they initiated. Below is his summary of the acceptance letter from the AACA.

"The AACA National Judging Committee has initiated a program for certified Designated Limited Production, Prototype, and Experimental Vehicles in Class 35 A/B. Upon receipt of the committee's approval of your 1970 Jeep Bolide XJ002 into Class 35A, the vehicle has been added to AACA records, Car Number 39726. Your 1970 Jeep Bolide XJ002 is the 9th prototype, 35th unique vehicle, and 99th overall vehicle to be accepted to Class 35A. It is the only one known to the AACA."
