The meeting was adjourned at 7:50 PM.

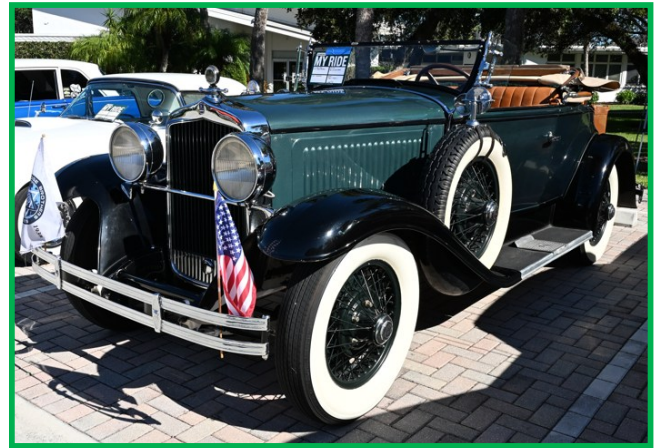

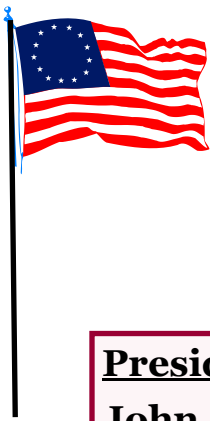

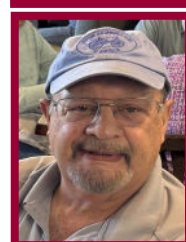
