

January in Automotive History

January 3rd, 1899

The New York Times published an editorial that used the word "automobile", and it was the first recorded use of the word.

January 12, 1900

The first commercial vehicle was completed by The Detroit Automobile Company. It was a delivery wagon designed by Henry Ford before he started his own company.

January 12th, 1904

Barney Oldfield set a new speed record of 91.37 miles per hour driving a stripped down Ford across Lake St. Clair while it was frozen.

January 25th, 1905

British driver Arthur MacDonald set a new land speed record at Daytona Beach, Florida going 149.875 miles per hour.

January 15th, 1909

The first motorized hearse was used in Chicago replacing the horse-drawn hearse.

January 11th, 1913

The Hudson Motor Car Company was the first to introduce an enclosed car with the Model 54 sedan. Previously, cars had a convertible roof or an open cab.

January 17th, 1949

The United States was invaded by a German bug, the <u>Volkswagen Beetle</u> to be exact. As of January 2014, over 5.5 billion have been sold in the United States.

January 16th, 1953

The iconic Chevrolet Corvette made its first appearance at a car show in New York's Waldorf-Astoria Hotel, and it is still going strong today.




